Obstetric Anesthesiologist Involvement on State Maternal Mortality Review Committees (MMRCs): A Survey of SOAP State Representatives and MMRC Members

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INTRODUCTION

- Up to 84% of **US maternal deaths** are preventable
- MMRCs review deaths and provide state-level, actionable data
- Obstetric anesthesiologists should be represented on each state MMRC
- The SOAP State Representatives Program was founded in 2022
 - → tasked to identify a rep for every state, evaluate state MMRC membership

AIM: evaluate OB anesthesiologist representation on each state MMRC





METHODS



The SOAP State Representatives Directory was accessed

→ listed State Representatives and MMRC members were emailed a survey



- Verify your role as a SOAP State Representative, MMRC member, or both
- Did MMRC anesthesia membership precede or follow the State Reps program?



MMRC member survey questions:

- What were the top three causes of maternal death reviewed?
- What support would you like from the State Reps program?










RESULTS

53 State Reps and 22 MMRC members identified on website → surveyed

- → response from 44 (66%)
- 29 State Reps (54%)
- 19 MMRC members (86%)





- 13 started prior to the program (68%)
- 4 joined through program (21%)
- 2 did not specify (11%)

CONCLUSION





- Further OB anesthesiologist representation is needed in state MMRCs
- The SOAP State Representatives Program can facilitate this initiative
- Top areas identified for further MMRC support: improved networking among OB anesthesiologists, development of easily distributable resources, development of a standardized directory
